## Significant Cases

- **SA v Secretary of State for the Home Department, Immigration and Asylum Chamber [June 2017]** – An appeal in Manchester against a Home Office decision to refuse the appellant's protection claim. The appellant was successful in arguing that her refusal of an arranged marriage would place her and her daughter at risk of violence if returned to Iraq, contrary to Articles 3 and 8 of the European Convention on Human Rights. The appellant and her daughter were given indefinite leave to remain in the UK.
- **CH, MV, SC and BC v Barnsley Metropolitan Borough Council [2018]** – A series of disrepair cases at Barnsley County Court in which the local authority argued that condensation was not caused by structural defects in the tenants' homes but by the tenants' lifestyles. Breaches of Section 11 of the Landlord and Tenant Act 1985 were established at trial in each case, and compensation paid to the tenants for damage to their own possessions.
